The Market over the past few weeks has mostly traded sideways, with some ups and some downs in certain spots. We had one good size sale and two moderate size sales in that timeframe and all classes would be called steady in most cases. We have seen an uptick in prices on the grass weight, steers and heifers if they have Hardy condition, good quality and the proper vaccinations, with some good test on 475 to 625 weights two of the three weeks. The extreme light grass weight cattle, not in big supply on the right kind, but certainly showing up trending demand on the few we have seen. Feeder cattle called mostly steady with some slightly improved demand on all weight classes of feeder cattle. Most of that improvement is on the better condition Cattle for sure. As noted many times we do see big price gaps on the same weight class Cattle, depending on age, condition, quality and vaccinations. We are seeing extra wide gaps at this time, we look for this to narrow through winter into the spring. As for the butcher cows, we are still seeing record prices as they seem to have become the norm. That said we do have to note a softer tone on the middle and lower classes of cows, and do feel this will be the norm at least through the rest of the year, with some upticks along the way, depending on who and how bad they need them. Higher end cows, although a bit more spotty now with prices in a very wide range still selling at the upper end of that range on most of the better young to middle age cows. Look for this to be the norm right along as there are more end users for this class.

Last week we did have a special offering of close-up fall calvers and a few fall pairs. This was the first real offering since the June cow sale. Although they were Montana cows shipped in they were from one ranch and good quality, but mostly middle aged and they still seem to meet very good demand selling from 2800 to 3200 with most of the 4 to 6-year-olds 3000 to 3200 on the close-ups. If you need some fall calving females look for this year's 30th annual bull sale to have a very good young offering! Sunday, September 15 at 12 o'clock we will be having our 30th annual Cattlemen's Select Bull Sale. We will start with around 100 plus nice young fall bred females featuring 45 coming 3 yr olds from one ranch (Wiabel Ranch) Foothill and Anaplaz vaccinated run 2 seasons in the Sierra mountain foothills. Bred to 44 Farms and Rhoades Ranch low birth angus bulls. Plus a good offering of some local first calvers from several local ranches. Hope to see ya there!
