The Market over the past few weeks has stayed relatively steady on most all classes. We have seen the grass weight cattle stay in very high demand especially on the better end. The extreme light ones must have very front end quality and shots and then sky is the limit, with the plainer or no shot Cattle in this weight class bringing over a dollar a pound less in some cases. Feeder weight Cattle selling mostly steady to slightly lower with moderate demand if there is a good offering, with the plainer or minimal shot Cattle selling \$20-\$40 per hundred weight lower. Look for rain to keep grass weight cattle steady and in good demand, but be advised if we get well into winter with no significant moisture, they will also likely sell cheaper with more limited demand. Butcher cows and bulls, which have stayed extremely firm for the longest time have backed off some, as talked about previously it is usually always the case when the fall run of cows start around the country. Although we would note that this year the price decline is much less than we have typically been used to seeing. This is a testament to the lower cow numbers overall and the culling rates of fall marketed cows. Butcher cows called \$10 lower on the very high-end cows with the medium and lower end cows \$15-\$20 cheaper compared to the previous 6 to 8 months. Bred cows and pairs no good test week to week with nothing of any significance being marketed.

Several weeks ago, we did have our fall producer meetings at VLM and the Paso Robles event center. Both were very well attended and received as there was good food good friends and good info. Thank you to SLO County Cattlemen and Bonnie and Claude Loftus as well as Momma K's Cafe. Special talks by Ranchbot Monitoring Solutions, FerAppease as well as near term and long-term market updates seem to be very useful to all that came.
