The future's market has had a good bounce back over the past week or two and this has added

some optimism back, especially on the lighter cattle. Lightweight cattle a solid five to \$10 higher this week with the middleweights up five dollars for the most part. We would look for this to continue to be the trend as we are moving closer to the rainy season. Heavier weights in a smaller offering this week called fully steady. Butcher cows also showing some added demand selling mostly five dollars higher with the higher end

cows called \$5 to \$10 higher. Cow numbers should remain tighter than normal moving into the fall marketing season, but one would have to think butcher prices will still soften some as the seasonal trend prevails. Bred cows and pairs still in excellent demand. The Sunday before last was our Annual Cattlemen's Select Bull sale and there was a small offering of young females prior to the bulls. Most all young good quality pairs and close

-ups brought \$3000-\$3400. There was also a great lineup of top breeding bulls, probably our most consistent offering to date. All breeds were met was solid demand.
